High- and low-level design, as-built documentation and technology selection — the engineering record most estates are missing.

What we are usually called in for

A design that exists only in someone's head is a risk on the balance sheet, and it is remarkable how many estates are in that position. The person who built it has moved on, the documentation describes an earlier version, and every change is now an investigation before it is a change.

It also narrows your options commercially. An estate only one supplier understands is an estate with one possible supplier, and both sides eventually feel it.

Our approach

We produce design documentation to a standard another competent engineer could implement from: architecture and topology at high level, interface and configuration detail at low level, and a version history so past decisions stay traceable.

Where the work is selection rather than design, we are vendor-neutral by default. The requirement chooses the technology; we make the trade-offs explicit enough that the decision survives the next review.

What the work involves

High-level design

Architecture, topology and technology selection tied to stated business and compliance requirements, with the reasoning attached.

Low-level design

Interface-level detail, addressing, configuration standards and implementation procedures — enough for someone else to build from.

Change & version control

Every design revision tracked, so as-built records stay true and past decisions stay explicable a year later.

Assessment & strategy

Infrastructure review, gap analysis, roadmap definition and vendor-neutral technology selection, sequenced by dependency and risk.

Review

Current estate, documentation and the decisions behind it, examined rather than accepted

Gap analysis

What is missing, what is at risk, and what is fine but undocumented

High-level design

Architecture and technology selection tied to the stated requirement

Low-level design

Interface detail, addressing and configuration standards — buildable by someone else

Maintain

Revisions tracked, so the as-built record and the running estate stay the same thing

What is delivered

Every engagement ends with something you keep. For this service, that is:
